NC Indian Senior Citizen's Coalition Princess Pageant 2025

Ladies age 55 or older are invited to participate in the NCISCC Princess Pageant. The pageant will be held on the evening of the conference, November 14, 2025 beginning at 6:00 p.m. A Banquet Ticket (including pageant and Fashion Show) is required for attendees at the cost of \$36.00. If planning to attend the pageant **only**, separate tickets will be available at the cost of \$20.00. Go to registration to purchase tickets.

Contestants competing in the pageant will be judged on **Personal Introduction, Talent (contemporary or traditional) and Regalia**. There is NO FORMAL WEAR required. All contestants must meet the following criteria:

- Must be 55 or older by the date of the pageant.
- Must be a resident of North Carolina.
- Must be a member of a NC state or federally recognized tribe.
- Must be sponsored by a NC state or federally recognized tribe or tribal organization.
- Must have NEVER WON the title of NCISCC Princess before.
- Must submit, with application, **two** Letters of Recommendation for Outstanding Citizenship (one from the Tribe/Organization sponsoring the contestant, one from another related person; community member, church member, employer, etc)
- Must submit a completed and signed contestant application by October 17, 2025, **including a headshot photo and regalia description. (NO EXCEPTION)**
- Must be knowledgeable about the North Carolina recognized tribes (seven state and one federal) and the four Urban Organizations.
- Must be willing and available to attend various events as determined by NCISCC Board.
- Cannot wear two crowns.
- Cannot wear your crown or sash (if you are a current princess of any type) during the conference.

Personal Introduction

- Contestants will introduce themselves: name, place of residence and tribal affiliation.
- Following the introduction, the contestant will speak on: If chosen as Ms. North Carolina Indian Senior Citizen what message would you convey about American Indians in North Carolina to the general public?
- The introduction should not exceed 2 minutes.
